# How To Create A Shaker Box 

 Materials: The Big Score Board • Construction Cardstock 12"x20" • Red Liner Tape • Scissors • Ruler • Printed Cardstock
## Directions

Step 1: To make the base of the box, cut a piece of cardstock $8^{\prime \prime} \times 18.5 "$. Place the short edge of the cardstock against the "box base" (landscape) and score 6 lines every 3 inches at 3", 6", 9", 12", $15 "$ and 18 ". You will need to shift the cardstock over to continue scoring all lines. (see figure1).

Step 2: To Create the lid, use another piece of cardstock that is $2 " \times 19.25$ " and place the short edge of the cardstock against the "box base" (landscape) and score 6 lines every 3 1/8" inches at $31 / 8^{\prime \prime}, 61 / 4$ ", $93 / 8^{\prime \prime}, 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 155 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $183 / 4$ ". You will need to shift the cardstock over to continue scoring all lines.(see figure 1)

Step 3 (lid) : Rotate the cardstock $90^{\circ}$ (portrait). Score along the entire length of the cardstock at 1.5" measuring from the left. (see figure 2).

Step 4 (base): Rotate the cardstock $90^{\circ}$ (portrait). Score along the entire length of the cardstock at 2" and 4" measuring from the left. (see figure 3).

Step 5 (lid): Fold all the score lines in. Snip narrow triangles as indicated in the photo. (see figure 4).

Step 6 (base): Score up from left to right at a $45^{\circ}$ angle in each of the 7 rectangular boxes along the top of the sheet (see figure 5).

Step 7 (base): Score up from right to left at a $45^{\circ}$ angle in each of the 6 rectangular boxes along the top of the sheet. In the last small rectangle score $45^{\circ}$ down from left to right. (see figure 6).

Step 8 (base): Fold all the score lines in. Cut off the triangles on top as indicated in the photo. (see figure 7).


Step 9 (base): Cut off the triangles leaving 1/2" above the score line. (see figure 8).


Step 10 (base): To create the lid use a hexagonal shape measuring 3 " on each side, add tape on each side of the hexagon shape and on the flap. (see figure 9). Tape one flap at time. (see figure 10)

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Step 11 (lid): To assemble the base, use a hexagonal shape measuring 3 1/8" on each side, add tape on each side of the hexagon shape and on the left side flap. (see figure 11). First - tape the flap (see figure 12)
Second - add more tape on the flaps for more support (see figure 13)
Third - tape sides one at the time (see figure 14)

Step 12: The box lid should now slide easily.
Your box is ready to decorate. (see figure 15).

Step 13: To decorate the base of the box cut 12 pieces ( 6 at $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and 6 at 2 " x 3 "), 12 triangles ( 6 at $21 / 2^{" x} \times{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " and 6 at 2 " $\times 1$ 1/2" $\times 1$ 1/2"). For the lid cut 12 pieces ( 6 at $23 / 4$ " $\times 1$ " and 6 at $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 / 4$ ") and two hexagonal shapes 1 measuaring 3 1/8" each side, and 1 shape measuring 2 1/2" each side of your printed cardstock. (see figure 16). Put these pieces around the base and the lid (see figure 17) click here for the templet


Decorate your Shaker Box as you wish.
